The Manitoba Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum works hard to display the history and success of the baseball talent throughout the province of Manitoba. Every year the museum inducts a handful of talented individuals who have showcased their hard work for the sport of baseball. Alongside the individuals, teams throughout the province that have made outstanding accomplishments are inducted. Individuals are recognized for their playing, coaching, umpiring and/or helping build their communities through baseball. The museums inductees are recognized at our annual induction banquet every year. A portrait and bio of the inductees are displayed in the museum for everyone to see. Our induction wall allows for community members to read up on local individuals from across the province and gain knowledge on the history of baseball within our communities.

The museum takes great pride in displaying baseball uniforms from different communities as well as uniforms from different decades. The uniforms allow for visitors to see and understand the changes that have taken place over the years within the sport and what has stayed the same. The museums uniform display showcases uniforms from each decade beginning at 1900 to the 1990's. All memorabilia in the museum has been generously donated by individuals. Continuous donations allow for the museum to constantly change out the displays with new memorabilia and showcase current teams that have been inducted into the museum. In 2002 the museum unveiled their new mural that displayed a baseball game during the past that then evolves to a game during the present. The mural was painted by Margie Hildebrand who took the museums objective of "Honour Our Past, Ensure Our Future" to create an authentic representation of a timeless baseball game. The museum continues to grow and make changes to improve how visitors interact with the museum. The museum is operated by a volunteer board from across Manitoba. Joe Wiwchar has been the volunteer Museum Manager since it opened in 1997. Joe has been actively coaching baseball in Manitoba for 65 years. The museum is able to continue to operate because of people like Joe.
